The County Commission of Mingo County met in Special Session on Friday, April 8, 2016, at 9:00 a.m. in the Commission Courtroom, Room 136, First Floor, Courthouse, Williamson, West Virginia. Present for the meeting were Commissioners Greg Smith and Diann Hannah. Commissioner John Mark Hubbard was absent.

A quorum being present and the public being duly notified, the meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Commissioner Smith.

Personnel: 9-1-1

Steven Marcum

Lorene Vance, 9-1-1, appeared before the Commission for personnel issues.

Vance stated she has issued warnings to Steven Marcum several times due to being late, etc. Vance stated this last warning will make 6 that he will have received. Vance recommended termination.

Commissioner Smith made a Motion to approve the recommendation and terminate Steven Marcum, at-will employee, effective immediately. Commissioner Hannah seconded. The vote was 2 yes. Motion carried.

Josh Tincher

Vance stated that Josh Tincher has not completed his training necessary to remain a dispatcher. Vance stated she has scheduled him several times he has not attended. Vance recommended terminating Tincher.

Commissioner Smith made a Motion to approve the recommendation of Vance and remove Tincher from the part-time dispatcher list on grounds of not completing necessary training. Commissioner Hannah seconded. The vote was 2 yes. Motion carried.

Scott Smith

Vance stated that Scott Smith has completed his APCO training and is now eligible for a \$1.00 (one dollar) per hour raise.

Commissioner Smith made a Motion to increase Scott Smith's salary \$1.00/per hour pursuant to past practice upon completion of training effective April 16, 2016. Commissioner Hannah seconded. The vote was 2 yes. Motion carried.
